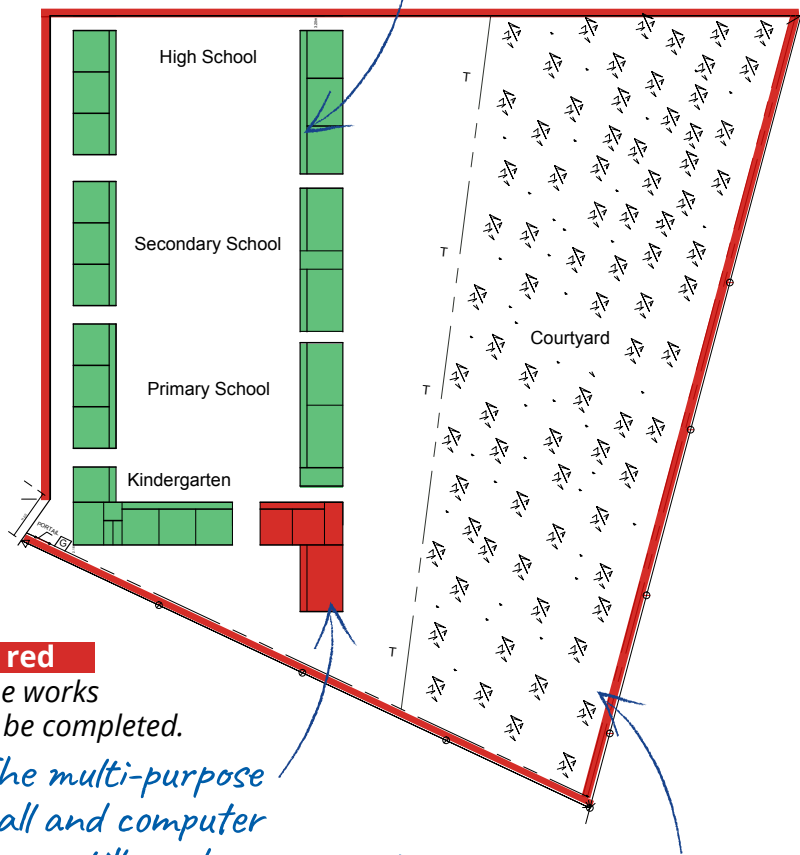


WORK IN PROGRESS

Thanks to the generosity of many benefactors, the **17 classrooms, bathrooms and veranda at St. Clare School in Djiri, Congo Brazzaville, are ready.** Pupils will no longer have to attend school in shifts, and the poorest and most remote children will no longer have to miss classes.
